- We will comply with current and future environmental legislation and regulatory requirements
- We will look towards best practice where we can reduce our environmental impacts of our activities and policies
- We will minimise the amount of waste produced by the council and encourage greater reuse, recycling and composting
- We will use the least environmentally damaging goods and services where possible
- We will manage assets under the Council's control to conserve, enhance and restore local heritage
- We will consider environmental factors in Council decisions and activities

Monitoring

The requirements of the Environmental Policy will be regularly monitored by the Council and will be reviewed on an annual basis.
