

## Website Accessibility Regulations

Report by the Clerk/RFO

Members will recall that there are new website accessibility regulations that the Parish Council has to adhere to legally.

The website administrator has reviewed the website and although compliant it would benefit from some updates to bring up to-date and improve accessibility.

He has made the following recommendations:

“A new visual theme update would mean a more secure and stable website, faster update times and much better performances (especially in speed and layout on mobile and touchscreen devices).

The look can keep any images and colour scheme from the existing website but will certainly look more modern in terms of typography and can accommodate larger and sharper imagery and would also adapt to screens of all sizes.”

He quotes between £280 - £350 for upgrading the website. This could be funded by virement in full of the underspend in audit budget line of £200 (no external audit required) and the balance from capital (£1500 in budget -no spend/commitments to-date).

**Members are asked to resolve whether they want to authorise the updating of the website.**
